What: LEAPS Academy is a 3 day and 2 night health and safety service-learning leadership development program

When: April Vacation 16th-18th

Recruit a group of 4-6 teens interested in workers' safety and an adult advisor. Teens and their adult advisor participate in the Academy. Afterward, teams develop a community project or event, to be implemented in their community.

Why:

- ◆ Bring together teens from across the state in hands-on activities focused on worker safety, worker rights, and workplace violence prevention.
- ◆ Provide youth with critical skills and hands-on opportunities to develop their leadership and teaching skills.
- ◆ Teens return back to their communities and conduct an action plan focused on promoting youth worker safety and preventing workplace violence.
- ◆ All participants who complete and implement a project receive a \$50 stipend
